<u>Elections</u> There will be no voting at the meetings, but nominations for District Delegates and State Directors may be made at any of the meetings, or any time up to Friday March 3 by calling, emailing, or texting the office. Only residents of a district may nominate a Delegate or Director, or Alternate for that district. Ballots will be sent out to attendees after nominations close on March 3. Elections for Corporate Director will be held for the Northeast and Central Districts (Scapanski, Bechtold seats). Resolutions will be accepted during any of the meetings or in writing by mail or email received at the office by the end of business on March 17.

Fee increases

2022 was a challenging year with labor shortages, vehicle shortages, gas price fluctuations, and rising costs of sample transportation, postage, and virtually all supplies. The 2023 budget calls for small increases in lab, sample transportation, reports (passing along price increases), and in some cases field tech pay and health insurance. As those are programmed in they will become effective on your sample day bill this spring. Some reports will have a \$1 per herd fee added: Lactation Report, Herd Summary, SCC, Reproduction Report, Youngstock, Genetic Evaluation, and SCC Tank. Lab price per sample for butterfat, protein, SCC, and MUN goes up 1.5 cents per sample. Sample transportation adds \$2.50 per herd since SpeeDee charges per tote not by weight alone, and their prices have gone up, as has the cost of vials and totes.
