March Month-end Numbers

RHA milk is an all-time high at 25,449 lbs with a 4.19% fat and a 3.25% protein - also all-time highs.

Sample Day milk was 71.4 lbs per cow - another all-time high.

SCC was slightly up from a year ago and is the second lowest SCC of all Marchs (196,311)

Lab sample volume was the highest since March of 2021. Preg numbers also the highest in 2 years and we expect to surpass 600,000 cows in July. We expect to pass 250,000 cows milk tested for Johne's by year-end.

Happy Milestone Anniversary to Jim Sheehan of Plainview who celebrates 35 years of service in April. We thank you for all of your hard work and dedication.
