Select Dry Cow Therapy is now being practiced by some herds. You may be able to save time and money, and anti-biotics by only dry treating cows that are likely to benefit. Dairy Comp Unlimited and a new DHIA report scheduled for September release can help – see details next month!

Ways to improve tractor operator safety include:

Ensuring an approved cab or roll-over protective structure (ROPS) is fitted.

Fitting and using a seatbelt on tractors with ROPS.

Fitting a seat with side restraints and a back rest to reduce the risk of back strain.

Wearing hearing protection - not all tractor cabs are soundproof.

Keeping children away from tractors and machinery.

Having an up-to-date maintenance schedule.

Following safe maintenance and jacking procedures.

Always mounting and dismounting on a tractor's left side in order to avoid the controls.

Keeping all guards in place, including the power take-off (PTO). Operating the self-starter from the operator position only.
