- Reduce expenses
- Optimize antibiotic use

Is my herd eligible for Select Dry Cow Therapy?

- At least 8 DHIA tests in the past year
- SCC below 250,000 for the year
- Less than 3 sample days with over 250,000

Which Cows should I consider for SDCT?

- Last DHIA test under 200,000
- Average of last 3 tests under 200,000
- No more than one clinical mastitis case in the this lactation
- Less than 99 days expected dry period

Cows meeting the eligibility list for use of SDCT are highlighted in green on the report for your convenience.

• Continue use of teat sealant

Useful Comparison Tool:

The ME\$ Value applies the USDA Dollar Value formula to a cow's 305ME values for milk, butterfat, and protein. This replaced ME Milk on your Lactation report to include quality, fat, and protein for a more valuable comparison. It also takes into account the lactation average SCC. We call it ME\$ because it allows you to look at and compare all cows on their economic value as mature animals.

In the example to the right, the top cow has a Production Index of 75. She is 25% below the average cow.

Harvest is Right Around the Corner!

Please remember with the rush of harvest comes the importance of farm safety. According to the U.S. Agriculture Fatality Statistics, more than 150,000 farm workers were injured on the job between 1992 and 2002. This figure has remained fairly consistent in more recent years and has even increased periodically. Here are a few harvest safety tips to keep in mind:

- 1. While operating tractors and other farm equipment, be very cautious on rural roadways. Look for oncoming cars while making wide turns.
- 2. Watch out for power lines.
- 3. Ensure your equipment has roll over protection such as seat belts and roll over protection structures
- 4. Be sure to do regular maintenance and safety checks on tractors and equipment. Check the steps and platform regularly, keep up-to-date with routine maintenance and replace damaged and worn out parts.
- 5. If you have employees or your children are helping, make sure they take all the necessary precautions as well!
