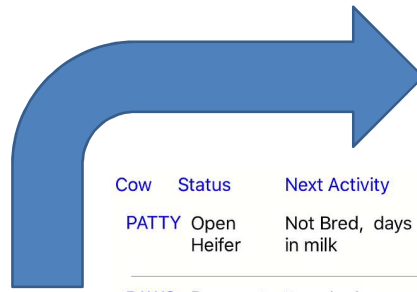
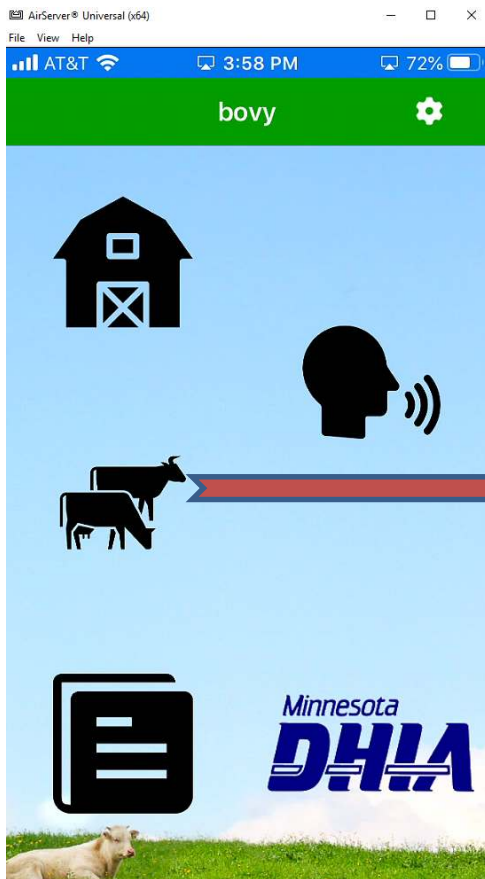

Cow PAWS is in pen 1, 288 days in milk, and milking 78 pounds. She was last bred 135 days ago on August 25, and is due on May 31.

Tap on the cows icon to get a list of your cows with their status and the next activity such as breed, preg check, dry off, due to calve.

Tap on a specific cow and get additional detail for that cow including the timeline, Reproduction, Identification and Production screens.

Our new APP is called **BOVY**. It allows you to look up information from your smart phone when you are standing next to the cow or leaning on the fence or sitting in church. BOVY uses the download provided by Minnesota DHIA, which includes your latest sample day and lots of other information. BOVY is not software – it is an APP you can get for either android or iPhone from your APP Store, and it is free to download and takes seconds. You can ask BOVY questions use the voice feature, or you can type in your request, or you can select from a list of questions that are preloaded. Here are some BOVY screens from my smart phone. BOVY can also supply you with lists. When you are on a list of cows, simply tap on the cow and you will get up to 3 additional pages of information such as the timeline shown above, and information on Repro, ID, and Milk production. It makes it faster and easier to find information on a cow while you are looking at her and saving the time it would take to sort through your paper records.

While the app is free, BOVY costs \$10 month. We post your update automatically as soon as your herd is ready. Then we email you that your new data is ready to be added. You tap on the app and tap on the barn to update. In a couple of seconds you have your new DHIA data in the app.

Please call Val (800-827-3442 x 35) at Minnesota DHIA for more information, or talk to your field tech. Some of them already have the app on the phone and could easily add your herd to demo it.

Spotlight on First Lactation Animals

Heifers are the future of your herd; therefore, it is essential to make sure they are off to a good start. The Yearly SCC Summary section, located in the middle of your Herd Summary shows the percent of animals throughout the year that have had an SCC over 200,000. The number of samples this reflects is displayed below the Yearly SCC box. Yellow highlights will appear in "Yearly SCC Summary" if lactation one animals have a higher infection rate than any other lactation in the first 30 DIM. The highlight is designed to draw attention to when and where a problem occurs.
